Items for discussion and possible action:

1. Public Comment and Communication: Price County Tavern League is trying to get the Safe Ride program running, but can't get drivers.
2. Meeting Minutes – August 9, 2019: Motion Hallstrand/Palecek to approve the minutes of the August 9, 2019 meeting as presented. Motion carried.
3. Coroner's Report and Vouchers: Motion Hallstrand/Bocock to approve the vouchers in the amount of \$9,707.24. Motion carried.
4. District Attorney's Report and Vouchers: Motion Hallstrand/Palecek to approve the vouchers in the amount of \$4,478.04. Motion carried.
5. Clerk of Circuit Court's Report and Vouchers: Motion Hallstrand/Bocock to approve the vouchers in the amount of \$33,493.52. Motion carried.
6. Sheriff's Office Report and Vouchers – Schmidt: 911 and Com Log have been installed. Price County will not get any of the state grant money. The two 2019 squads will arrive in January and the 2020 squads will arrive in February. Training program in place for jailer/dispatch and transitioning deputies from dispatch to road coverage. 8. Humane Office Update: Deputy Merlak is promoting the program. The vehicle is being outfitted for animal pickup. Working with Catkins to get their facility organized for accepting retrieved animals.
