 - b. New HazMat Reporting system for Co. HazMat Response Team - WI Fire Bridge: Documents incident details: date, location, type, resources, actions taken, responders. WebEOC to be used for local events.
7. Community outreach: Will have command post at Flambeau Rama.
 - a. Booth at Sport and Home Show – Park Falls: Attended at Flambeau Lanes.
 - b. Price County Fair: Aug. 22-26: Will have a booth and possibly command post.
