Request for Proposals

“Chip Seal and Fog Seal 7.5 miles CTH E & 3.75 miles CTH F”

Proposals will be received by the Price County Highway Department for the seal coating of 7.5 miles of CTH E, (CTH B North to the Sawyer County Line), 3.75 miles of CTH F (STH 70 south for 3.75 miles) in Price County, Wisconsin.

Proposals will be received at the Office of the Price County Highway Commissioner until 3:30 PM, Thursday, April 2, 2020.

The Price County Highway Department reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, or to accept any proposal, they deem in the best interest of Price County.

INSTRUCTIONS TO SUBMITTERS

Proposals will be received by the Price County Highway Department for seal coating 11.25 miles of County Trunk Highway E & F.

LOCATION OF WORK – The work is located on County Trunk Highway E and F in northwest Price County.

GENERAL – The selection process will include consideration of price, adherence to specifications, warranty, and references. Low proposal will not be the limiting factor to award.

FORM OF PROPOSAL – The submitter must submit his proposal on the form furnished and here unto attached. All writing shall be done in ink.

REQUIREMENT FOR SIGNING PROPOSAL – The full name and business address of each submitter must be entered in any and all proposals submitted. Each proposal shall be signed in the space provided therefore by written signature of the person or persons properly authorized to sign it.

SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL – The proposal shall be placed in an envelope or in separate envelopes which shall be sealed. On the envelope or envelopes shall be plainly written “County Trunk Highway E & F” Seal Coating, 2020”. Such envelopes shall be addressed and delivered to the Office of the Price County Highway Commissioner, 704 North Lake Avenue, Phillips, WI 54555 before the time specified in the Request for Proposal (RFP).

WITHDRAWAL OF PROPOSAL – Submitters may withdraw his/her proposal at any time prior to the scheduled time for the receipt of proposals provided the request is communicated to the Highway Commissioner before the time set for opening proposals.

REJECTION OF PROPOSAL – The County Highway Commissioner reserves the right to reject any and all proposals or to accept any proposal deemed in the best interest of the Price Highway Department and waive any formalities or irregularities in proposals.

TIME – All proposals must be submitted to the Price County Highway Commissioner’s Office by 3:30 PM on April 2, 2020.

PURCHASE PRICE – The purchase price shall include all work to be performed, labor, materials, necessary tools, expendable equipment, freight, utility and transportation services, and incidentals necessary to furnish the materials.

INSURANCE – A certificate of liability insurance will also be required for the project.

Submitter shall maintain the following insurance:

Worker’s Compensation:

- a. Coverage A: Limits – Statutory
- b. Coverage B: Employer’s Liability Limits
- c. Bodily Injury by Accident - \$100,000 each accident minimum
- d. Bodily Injury by Disease - \$100,000 each employee minimum
- e. Bodily Injury by Disease - \$500,000 policy limit minimum

Comprehensive General Liability Limits: \$1,000,000 bodily injury and \$1,000,000 property damage.

Automobile Liability Insurance, with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 for each person and \$1,000,000 for each accident.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

GENERAL – The work under this contract for the seal coating of County Trunk Highway E and F, in Price County Wisconsin shall be in accordance with the exhibits therefore and shall comply with the requirement of the State of Wisconsin, Department of Transportation, Section 455 Standard Specifications for Highway and Structure Construction, and these Special Provisions. All quantities will be measured in English units. Wherever the Standard Specifications use metric units, appropriate conversions to English units shall be made.

SCOPE OF WORK – The work under this contract shall consist of the application of a seal coat and subsequent fog seal and all incidental items necessary to complete the work. Start of construction the last week of July is desirable.

PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS – Work shall begin within ten calendar days after a written notice to do so have been issued by the Highway Commissioner. Fog seal must be placed within three working days after the placement of the seal coat.

TRAFFIC – County Trunk Highway E and F will be open to traffic during the construction operation. The County shall provide appropriate flaggers, pilot vehicles and signage to control traffic during product application. Material will be applied as to allow for one lane of traffic at all times. The cost of providing additional flaggers and signage from offloading, nurse trucks etc. will be incidental to the project cost and shall be included in the contractor's cost per gallon proposal. Traffic control shall be done in accordance with 2020 Wisconsin Flaggers Handbook the latest revision of Part VI, Traffic Controls for Construction and Maintenance Operations of the Wisconsin Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

WORK BY OTHERS – Price County Highway Department forces will perform a number of items of work on the proposed project including the following:

- A. Installation of temporary traffic control, pavement markings, chips and all incidental items other than the supply and application of asphaltic materials.
- B. Permanent pavement marking.

SEAL COAT – All work shall be in compliance with Section 408 of the Standard Specifications and AASHTO M-316.

FOG SEAL COAT – All work shall be in compliance with Section 408 of the Standard Specifications and AASHTO M-316.

ASPHALTIC MATERIAL – Asphaltic material for the seal coat shall be CRS-2 or HSRF-2 with a temperature of application of 125 - 170° F. The material shall be in conformance with Section 401.3 of the Standard Specifications. The asphaltic material will be measured by the gallon incorporated into the work. The material shall be applied at the rate of 0.36 gallon per square yard for chip seal and 0.11 gallons per square yard for fog seal if not otherwise specified. Application rates may be adjusted in the field. Asphaltic material will be measured by the gallon. Measurement by volume will be in accordance with the pertinent provisions set forth under Subsection 401.3.3 of the Standard Specifications. Deductions will be made for any quantities which are wasted or not actually incorporated in the work in accordance with the contract.

WARRANTY – The seal coat shall be warrantied from stripping, loss of aggregate, bleeding, etc., for one year after the date of completion if determined by the department. Warranty costs will only be sought in the event of a failed test of the material supplied and applied.

The undersigned, having familiarized themselves with the local conditions affecting the cost of the work and with the Specification and Proposal Instructions hereby proposed to do all work to be performed and to provide and furnish all of the labor, materials, necessary tools, expendable equipment, stockpile sites, and all utility and transportation services necessary to place the seal coat for the following prices. Proposal unit prices are for product applied. If application is separated the cost must be shown on the proposal form indicating application only or product only:
