PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS

The submitter, signing and submitting this proposal, agrees and declares as a condition thereof, to be bound by the following conditions and requirements:

The submitter declares that he has carefully examined the specifications and/or contract forms for the work contemplated, and it is assumed that the submitter has investigated and is satisfied as to the conditions to be encountered, as to the character, quality and quantities of the work to be performed and materials to be furnished, and as to the requirements of the specifications and any special provisions. It is mutually agreed that the submission of a proposal shall be considered conclusive evidence that the submitter has made such examination.

The submitter declares that he understands that the estimate of quantities in the attached schedule is approximate only and that the attached quantities may be greater or less in accordance with the specifications. The submitter agrees to perform the said work, for and in consideration of the payment of the amount becoming due on account of work performed, according to the unit prices proposal in the following schedule, and to accept such amounts in full payment of said work.

The submitter declares that all of the said work will be performed at his own proper cost and expense, that he will furnish all necessary material (except material mined on-site), labor, tools, machinery, apparatus, and other means of construction in the manner provided in the applicable specifications and the approved plans for the work, and agrees that this proposal will become part of the contract upon acceptance by the County.

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It will be required that the successful submitter shall furnish certificates of liability insurance to the County Highway Department. County shall be named as an additional insured on all policies of Comprehensive General Liability Insurance and Automobile Liability Insurance. Failure of County to demand such certificates or other evidence of full compliance with these insurance requirements or failure of County to identify a deficiency from evidence provided shall not be construed as a waiver of submitters obligation to maintain such insurance.

Submitter shall maintain the following insurance:

Worker's Compensation:

- a. Coverage A: Limits – Statutory
- b. Coverage B: Employer's Liability Limits
- c. Bodily Injury by Accident - \$100,000 each accident minimum
- d. Bodily Injury by Disease - \$100,000 each employee minimum
- e. Bodily Injury by Disease - \$500,000 policy limit minimum

Comprehensive General Liability Limits: \$1,000,000 bodily injury and \$1,000,000 property damage.
Automobile Liability Insurance, with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 for each person and \$1,000,000 for each accident.

3/8" chips are assumed for the purpose of this proposal to weigh 2,650 lbs. per cubic yard in the stockpile. Price County reserves the right to verify quantities by measuring the completed stockpiles with length x width x height, GPS or drone technology prior to payment if the quantities purchased are not scaled by truck load.

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Take all precautions to minimize contamination of the aggregate. We are looking for approximately 1600 tons of Seal Coat aggregate cover. The cost of seal coat aggregate alone will not determine the lowest responsible proposal for this project, location of the submitters pit and Price County's trucking costs will be considered in the determination of which price is most beneficial to Price County. The Price County trucks used for hauling will be reimbursed at the State Machinery Rate, as well as distance from the Price County shop location to the pit, along with the distance from the pit to the delivery locations. The County Highway Commissioner reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, or to accept the proposal, which is most advantageous to Price County. The County Highway Commissioner reserves the right to add or delete projects from the proposal to maintain their budget. All prices shall include all costs to produce specified materials including royalties.
